Original research articles

The manuscript should be structured as abstract, introduction, methods, results, discussion, conclusions, references, and tables and figures.

- o Word count – up to 4000
- o Structured abstract – up to 300 words
- o Tables/illustrations – up to 5
- o References – up to 100

Review articles

The manuscript should be structured as abstract, introduction, discussion, conclusions, references, and tables and figures.

- o Word count – up to 4000
- o Abstract – up to 300 words
- o Tables/illustrations – up to 5
- o References – up to 100

Case reports

The manuscript should be structured as abstract, background, case presentation, literature review/discussion, conclusions, take-home messages, references, and tables and figures.

- o Word count – up to 2500
- o Structured abstract – up to 200 words
- o Tables/illustrations – up to 5
- o References – up to 50

Expert opinions

This manuscript should include your professional opinion on a practice-relevant topic of interest.

- o Word count – up to 1500
- o References – up to 50
